- Garth House. They provide Christmas gifts and tree decorations for Children who have been abused and are seeking counseling there.
- Birthday bag drive. They were able to drop off 36 Birthday Bags to Minnie's Food Pantry.
- Children's Hospital – NICU Lovies. Lovies are flat, soft flannel hearts That have been embroidered "From my heart to yours" on one side. They are designed to transfer smells between baby and their parent. Each package contains 2 hearts. One is placed under the baby and the other is Given to the parent to keep next to their skin. When they visit the baby, They swap hearts, allowing smells to transfer between them.

- Collecting school supplies for Lorena ISD.
